

Development battery cabinet in Morocco

Shenzhen-listed Gotion Hi-Tech has unveiled plans to construct two lithium battery manufacturing facilities in Morocco and Slovakia, with annual production capacities of 20 GWh each.

The Sino-European group GOTION High-Tech, with Volkswagen as a key shareholder, is slated to build the first electric battery gigafactory in the Middle East and Africa.
