State tax credits for installing solar PV generally do not reduce federal tax credits--and vice versa.

You claim the solar tax credit by filing IRS Form 5695 with your federal tax return, allowing you to deduct 30% of your solar installation costs directly from your tax bill.

Only certain solar equipment and related expenses are eligible for the 30% tax credit, so make sure to
