



Labor wages for photovoltaic panel installation

How much do solar photovoltaic installers make a year?

The median annual wage for solar photovoltaic installers was \$51,860 in May 2024. Employment of solar photovoltaic installers is projected to grow 42 percent from 2024 to 2034, much faster than the average for all occupations. About 4,100 openings for solar photovoltaic installers are projected each year, on average, over the decade.

How much do solar panel installation jobs pay in 2025?

In 2025, solar panel installation jobs salary ranges in Texas and Florida are typically between \$46,000 and \$62,000 per year. The increase in utility-scale and residential installations--particularly in Austin, Houston, Miami, and Tampa--has raised both demand and pay for skilled solar workers.

How much do solar installers make in California?

California: California consistently leads the country in solar deployment, and solar installer salary ranges reflect that. Most solar panel installer salaries in California fall between \$55,000 and \$72,000 per year, with top earners making even more in high-cost metro areas like San Francisco or Los Angeles.

How do solar installers get paid?
