What are the different types of lithium ion cells?

There are three different constructions of lithium-ion cells: Cylindrical: These cells are tube-like in shape, where the positive and negative electrodes, separator, and electrolyte are all contained within a metal casing. The most common format is the 18650 (18mm diameter, 65mm length).
