Wind turbines are predominantly made of steel (66-79 of total turbine mass), fiberglass, resin or plastic (11-16), iron or cast iron (5-17), and copper. Blades are the most important composite ...

Blades serve as the core components that capture wind energy. Typically, manufacturers construct them from glass fiber reinforced plastic (GFRP) or carbon fiber reinforced plastic (CFRP).
